SAINT JOSEPH : PATRON SAINT

Saint Joseph, the husband of Holy Mary and foster father of Jesus, lived in the first century A.D at Nazareth, in the modern Israel. From the Bible (the New Testament) we come to know that he was a God-fearing, just and hardworking man; he was a carpenter by profession. He was obedient to God's plans and was always ready to listen to the promptings and guidance of the Spirit of God. He is regarded as the Patron Saint of workers.

As a good Jewish father, along with his wife Mary, gave their Son, Jesus, religious education; they taught him values and life-skills. It is thus legitimate that he is admired as the patron for good education, filled with values and wisdom. We therefore dedicate our school, staff and students, to the paternal care of Saint Joseph, so that he may ever inspire us all to be God fearing and hardworking, wise and disciplined. We thank God for al the blessings and protection that we experience in and through the intercession of our Patron, Saint Joseph.

PROSPECTUS

Saint Joseph's school is a Catholic Minority School established and conducted by the Catholic Diocese of Bhagalpur for the education of the Boys and girls up to higher secondary level. This School is open to all without distinction of caste or creed. It is run by "Bhagalpur Prefecture Association" (BPA), a Registered Society under Registration Act XXI of I860, the Diocesan Fathers of Bhagalpur Diocese. The Diocese has a chain of schools such as Saint Joseph's School - Bhagalpur, Banka, Jamui, Jhajha, Giridih, Pakartalla-Kahalgaon, Jamua, Chakai etc and St. Thomas School, Godda, Govindpur, Barahat, Lalmatia, etc.

Saint Joseph's School, Devipur (Khirwatari) was established in the year 2015. It takes admission in this academic year 2023-2024 for the classes from Nursery to Class IX. The ambiance inside the campus is serene and salubrious and it facilitates a proper environment for education and fruitful training of life. Saint Joseph's School arms every student with the strength and depth of character that enable him/her to face the fiercely competitive world of today with ease and confidence.

OBJECTIVE

The School's objective is to give well balanced integral and all round development to young boys and girls by imparting an education which is morally, physically and mentally sound. In keeping with national aspiration, it helps the students become mature, spiritually oriented men and woman of character, active useful and worthy citizens of India. It is an institution where boys and girls grow up together in a healthy atmosphere of equality and mutual respect. The school aims at the integral development of the whole person, enlightened leadership, social responsibility and commitment to nation building.

TEN COMMANDMENTS FOR JOSEPHITES

- 2. A Josephite shall always behave in a polite and gentle manner.
- A Josephite shall always respect elders, parents and teachers.
- A Josephite shall always use fair means in all dealings examination etc.

- A Josephite shall always complete home assignments and other works entrusted to him/her.

CURRICULUM

The medium of instruction is English, but very special emphasis is given to Hindi the National language and Moral instruction which is essential for character formation is imparted to all pupils. Sanskrit also will be taught in the classes as the prescribed syllabus. It follows ICSE curriculum. Besides catering to the academic needs of its students, it gives great importance to the co-curricular activities such as physical training, sports and games, art and craft, singing, elocution, quiz, debate, etc. Occasions will be provided to the students to display their talents and hence positive encouragement and co-operation from parents will be essential. The school has a computer lab to allow the pupils to develop and poster their innate talents and keep abreast with the modern education from the very beginning.

DISCIPLINE

The whole hearted co-operation of the parents and guardians is expected at all times in the formation of the character of the children. The school will inherit on strict punctuality, regular attendance, cleanliness in dress, books and persons and fidelity to study and work assignments. Absence from school for merely social function will be strongly discouraged. Students are answerable to the school authorities for their conduct in and outside the school. Hence misbehaviour in public places and conveyances justifies dismissal, irregular attendance, habitual illness or idleness, objectionable moral behaviour, conduct detrimental to the ordinary life of the school, continual failure to make satisfactory progress in studies and above all discourtesy, disrespect and disobedience to the teachers and staff are such a sufficient cause for dismissal.

ADMISSION

- . Boys and Girls who are admitted to Nursery should be of minimum 3 years age.
- Students seeking admission to any other class except Nursery and LKG should sit for an admission test in English, Hindi and Mathematics on a date fixed by the Principal.
- Upon publication of the result of admission test, candidates are to take admission by paying all the preliminary fee.
- Birth Certificate and Aadhaar Card are must.
- Admission forms are given only to successful and selected students. Guardians are asked to fill in the admission form with utmost accuracy.
- A student who has attended any other school previously cannot be admitted without a Transfer Certificate (TC) and conduct certificate. It is a must for Classes II & above.
- Guardians are asked to fill in the admission form with accuracy. No changes will be permitted thereafter for any reason whatsoever.
- No changes in the admission form until be made after its submission in the school office.

EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

- . There are three major examinations in a year, i.e., Quarterly, Half yearly and Final , besides regular class tests. The pass marks is 40%.
- 2. Promotion is given on the basis of one year's work and not merely on marks scored in the final exams. Every student must be present for all the major exams. The average of these is taken at the end of the year. Total aggregate of 40% in each subject is a precondition for promotion. Classwork and homework are also assessed and awarded.
- Each student is required to be present for 90% of school days as a precondition for promotion.
- There shall be neither re-test nor re-exam for those who miss it for any reason.

- Anyone who resorts to unfair means in the examination will be dismissed instantly.
- The result declared at the end of the year is final and cannot be reconsidered. In all questions of promotion or failure, Principal's decision is final.
- 7. The jurisdiction over the admission documents, evaluated answer scripts and other works done by the students lie within the purview of the school and therefore an outside person or an authority has no jurisdiction to check, scrutinize or claim back the documents. Answer scripts are retained in the school only for a month after publishing the result. Answer scripts of the annua examination is not shown to the parents/students.

WITHDRAWAL

- Before withdrawing a student from the school, two month's notice is to be given or a month's fee in lieu of notice.
- Any pupil failing two years in the same class or failing twice in the three consecutive years will be struck off the rolls and transfer certificate will be issued.
- The principal reserves to himself the right to dismiss the students, who fail to make satisfactory progress in his or her studies or whose conduct in any way is detrimental to the discipline of the institution, for immorality, insubordination or contempt without prior notice to the parents.
- Not with standing anything to the prospectus, the Principal may at his absolute discretion ask any parent at any time to take his ward out o the school.
- The names of those who fail to pay the fee and the late fees up to final quarter will be struck off the rolls.
- The decision of the Principal in all matters pertaining to the admission and withdrawal of students shall be final and binding on all.
- No certificate will be issued until all the school fees have been paid in full and that too, only on receipt of a written application to the Principa from the parent.
- \$. The transfer certificate will be given on payment of `200.00

ATTENDENCE

- . 85% of attendance is required for the students in order to appear at any of the examination held in school.
- In case of leave of absence for more than three days due to sickness a letter of application along with a Medical certificate must be sent. For any leave of absence permission prior to the leave is a must.
- The leave application has to be counter signed by the person whose specimen signature is given on page of the school diary.
- Joining school after a short or long absence need permission of the Principal.
- Student, absent continuously for 15 days, without any information will be considered, as left the school and his/her name will be struck of the roll.
- Re-admission can be granted after paying the re-admission charge and full dues.
- It is imperative for the study progress of each child that she/he be present in school every day. Her/his presence before and immediately after the regular holidays is urgently requested. Those absent because of sickness must inform the school before the re-opening and present a medical certificate before they are admitted to class. Absence without leave for more than a week immediately before/ after a vacation renders the student liable for dismissal.
- All leave applications should bear the signature of the parents or in their absence of guardians. Failure to bring such an application for leave, will make the student liable to be sent home.
- No student should leave the school premises during the school hours without the written permission of the Principal which is granted on the written request of the parents.

DISMISSAL - SUSPENSION

The Principal reserves the right to remove a student from the school or suspend him/her for a certain period if the conduct of the student in Principal's opinion is against the good moral tone of the school.

Certain objectionable behaviours are the following:

- . Irregular attendance.
- 2. Disobedience and habitual idleness.
- 8. Rudeness to a staff member.
- 4. Dishonesty of any sort.
- 5. Any form of stealing.
- 6. Regularly not doing homework or class assignments.
- Cheating in examination/test.
- Writing on or deliberately spoiling school furniture equipment or library books.
- 9. Using obscene or vulgar language or acting in an indecent manner.
- 0. Lack of co-operation in school activities.

Students whose work and progress in studies are unsatisfactory may be sent away. A student who fails in his/her class, who is above the average age of the class will be liable for dismissal. The Principal is the sole judge regarding the dismissal of a student. He is not obliged to give any reason for the action in dismissing a student except that he is satisfied that the student is not fit to continue as a student of this school. The Principal also reserves to himself the right to suspend a student from attendence at the school and to determine the period of the suspension. The gravity of the offence and the degree of damage caused thereby to school, discipline will be factors considered when fixing this period.

SCHOOL FEES

Fees can be deposited through 'School App' or in the Bank, *or* as Cash in school office or a Cheque can be issued in favour of St. Joseph's School or amount can be electronically transferred to the School Account as mentioned in the Fee Book.

ime for paying the fees: School Office Hours.

- . The fees cover twelve calendar months and may be paid in quarterly installments or monthly (before the month ends) in advance. No reduction is made for holidays or broken periods. Pupils will be charged full fees as long as their names are officially on the rolls.
- 2. The school reserves its right to revise the fees without prior notice.
- Fees once paid will not be refundable for any reason.
- Annual increase in the tuition fee is normal.
- 5. The receipted counter-foils, the fee book should be kept by the students carefully and produced before the office counter at the time of next payment of fees. Fee Book should be filled in and signed before it is presented at the counter for payment of fees.
- Fees are payable only on school days during office hours from 1st to 15th of every alternative month without fine as mentioned in Fee Book.
- A fine of Rs. 100/- for each installment will be charged to the students who fail to pay the fees within the stipulated days.
- All dues must be cleared before the commencement of each examination. Any one who has not cleared the dues will not be allowed to appear for the examination.
- Pupils, whose fees are overdue to three months at any, their names will be taken off the register of the school without any warning whatsoever.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS DISCIPLINE

Along with the right to education, the students have a corresponding responsibility to co-operate fully with all persons employed by the school. Management and other persons have been assigned responsibility with respect to the service provided by the school management. Students are expected to be diligent in their studies and conform to the rules of the school, and submit to such discipline as would be exercised by a kind, firm and judicious parent.

The aim of the school is to develop among the students a sense of self-discipline. The true meaning of discipline is training of mind and character.

- Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence, habitual late coming, disobedience or objectionable behaviour of any kind may result in removal of a student from the school.
- Children are held responsible for unnecessary or willful damage to school property. A flat payment will be charged to help offset the cost of repairs or replacement as necessary
- Mobile Phones, Cameras, Electronic gadgets etc. are prohibited items in the campus. Students are advised not to wear wrist watches in the school. School management will not return the mobile phones and gadgets if caught from the students.
- English shall be spoken at all time in the school premises by the students and teachers.
- Students should take good care of their books and personal belongings. Each article should be marked with the pupil's name, admission number and class.
- The school is not responsible for goods lost. The students are discouraged from wearing ornaments and bringing any expensive article to the school.
- School Diary should be brought to school daily. Magazine, Newspapers, Novels, etc. are not to be brought to the school.

- All children are expected to bring "Tiffin" along with them for the noon recess. Students are not allowed to bring junk food. Tiffin and other articles will not be sent to the class for student during the class hours.
- Students shall not offer gifts or presents to their teachers or companions.
- 0. Parents and guardians are not allowed to see their ward or visit teachers or enter the school verandah during the school hours.
- 1. Those who bring children to school must come respectably dressed and leave the school immediately.
- 2. Homework should be done neatly and the day's work always dated in their notebooks and in the diary as well.
- Smoking, chewing gum, chewing pan, use of tobacco products, etc, are strictly forbidden in the school premises.
- 4. Students should treat others respectfully and are responsible for other's good name. Physical assault, gang formation, vandalism marking threat, calling nickname, using abusive and unparliamentary language, spreading rumours, etc. are strictly forbidden, and are liable to strict disciplinary action, including expulsion from the school.
- 5. On their way to and from school, students must behave in a gentlemanly manner.
- 6. Every student is expected to subscribe to small charities, if requested by the Principal. However, no fine, funds or collection will not be made in the school without the written permission or notice from the Principal.
- 7. Student are not allowed to call parents by phone/leave the school premises during school hours or recess without the explicit permission of the Principal/Vice- Principal. No child will be sent home even if some urgent need arises, unless a duly authorized person comes to fetch him/her with a note of authority from the parents or guardian together with the Identify Card of his/her ward.
- 8. It is compulsory for every student to take part in curricular and cocurricular activities organized by the school.

9. Personal cleanliness is very essential. The fingernails should be trimmed and unpolished, hands mehndi free and the shoes be polished daily. Wristwatch, Bangles, hairpin, rings, ornaments, jewellery, money, mobile, electronic gadgets, etc. are not allowed in the school. It is the policy of the school as a rule to discourage tuition as they may prove injurious to the real progress of the pupils.

ACCIDENTS

In the event of an accident several courses of action may be taken depending upon the seriousness of the accident

- Scrap and scratches, or any injury that can be treated with ointment and a bandage (First aid) will be dealt with at the school.
- In case of sprain, bruises or concussions the home will be notified immediately to decide what action should be taken.
- c) In case of open or heavily bleeding wounds, broken bones, unconsciousness, etc. the child will be taken to the Emergency Department at the Hospital and the parents will be notified immediately.

GUIDELINES FOR BOYS AND GIRLS IN SAINT JOSEPH'S SCHOOL

ATTITUDE TO GOD

- . Remember that we have been created in order to love and serve God, our creator and that all learning and wealth in this world amount to nothing without God on which our temporal and eternal welfare depends.
- Give glory to God for whatever learning you have, for He is the Author of every good. Do glory in all ability.
- Give yourself to the practice of virtue as you are young. The virtues to be cultivated the most is modesty (Purity), humility, obedience and kindness.

- Modesty means proper and decent manner of speaking and acting. This virtue is one of the best ornaments of your age.
- Avoid any kind of sin, especially the evil actions should be avoided. These evils draw down God's anger upon us, but if we keep them far away from us, God will never fail to bless us.

ATTITUDE TO TEACHERS

- . Students should look upon their schoolmates as brothers and sisters and upon their teachers and superiors as their parents.
- Respect every teacher whether of your own class or not. Be grateful towards those who taught you in the past. Show your teachers those exterior signs of reverence to which they are entitled, such as greeting them whenever you meet them.
- Be convinced that your teachers deeply feel their serious obligation of promoting your welfare in the best possible way and that in advising, commanding and correcting you, they have nothing else in view but your own good.
- After piety, study is the most praiseworthy, therefore, your first occupation must consist in doing the task assigned to you by your teachers.
- Always rise when your teachers enter the class and again when they leave. If they delay in coming do not make any noise but wait for them in your places in silence, reviewing your lesson or reading some good books.
- 5. During class avoid whispering or interrupting.

ATTITUDE TO SCHOOLMATES

- Strive to edify your schoolmates by your good example at all times, in fact no sermon is more efficacious than a good example.
- 2. Never make fun of those who are backward in their studies or not so quick to grasp their lesson. Let there be no ridiculing of any on account of his/her physical defects. What you laugh at or despise in other, may one day befall on you.

- 3. Gladly help one another. At recreation make no distinction in the choice of your companions. Let no one be slighted in any game and let there be no selfishness. If there be needed to make a sacrifice for the sake of the team let it be made cheerfully.
- When you are asked by a superior regarding the conduct of some of your companions answer to the best of your knowledge especially when it is a matter of preventing or remedying some evil, being silent would not be beneficial to your companion and would be offensive to God. Always avoid exaggeration and speak truthfully.

BEHAVIOUR AT SCHOOL

- To write or draw on the chalkboard (except when called upon to do so) the words of offence, to soil walls or maps or anything else are things absolutely to be avoided.
- Take great care of your text books, copy books and other belongings. Beware of appropriating your neighbour's property even if it were the smallest thing. If you find any lost article, give them at once to the Principal or to the School Office.
- Keep the floor clean by allowing no paper or ink to fall on it. Cleanliness and purity of you are reflected by clean and neat exterior.
- Speak no ill of your mates or of the discipline of management of the school. Everyone is perfectly free to remain or not to remain in the school.
- Always speak well of your school and of your teachers.
- Performance on the stage of the School Hall is promoted for your instruction and entertainment. They should help to bring out the fine qualities of your heart and never be an occasion of the least sin.
- To enter the hall in such a hurry or even to run at the risk of hurting your companions, trying to go ahead of other to secure a better seat, to stand when you should be seated, to shout, to whistle, to boo or hiss or giving evidence of disapproval or dislike etc. are things in particular to be avoided.

- Do not ridicule anyone for his/her mistakes. When the curtain is lowered applaud generously but not boisterously.
- Be tolerant when thing have not been according to your taste or as perfect as you expected them to be.
- In leaving the hall, do not push or shove one another, go out in an orderly manner.

SCHOOL BUS

- . Transportation for school children is arranged by the school for those residing in the town and roadside area but a seat in the bus is not guaranteed. The school bus runs through the main roads and halts at fixed places. Arrangements therefore must be made by the guardians to bring the children to the bus stop and take them back home.
- Conveyance fee is charged according to the distance and are to be paid along with tuition fees every alternative months. Fee of an entire month will be charged even for partial use of the conveyance in any month. Fee of 11 month will be charged.
- The school bus service is directly under the control of the Principal. Any suggestion or complain may be made only to the Principal and not to the bus staff.
- Reasonable care is taken by the school for the safety of the children in the school premises. But the school authorities shall not be held responsible for accidents and other eventualities which are beyond their control.
- A student should not be taken off the bus at stop that she/ he does not use each day. In case of serious need, a letter from parents should be written to the Principal a day in advance. So that correct procedures may be maintained.
- Students who want to discontinue the use of the school bus should inform the school authorities at least one month in advance.
- Conveyance facilities may be withdrawn for the disciplinary reasons. Students should not travel on the foot board of the bus. Students should not crowd the entrance of the bus at any time.
